Kementerian Sumber-Sumber Utama dan Pelancongan, Jabatan Perhutanan bersama dengan Syarikat Yi An Photo Studio (selaku ‘Event Coordinator’ menganjurkan Pertandingan “Brunei Wildlife Photography Challenge 2022 (BWPC 2022) bersempena sambutan “World Wildlife Day 2022” dengan tema pada tahun ini “Recovering key species for ecosystem restoration”.

Pada masa yang sama, Hari Hidupan Liar sedunia ini juga untuk mengingatkan kita akan keperluan dalam meningkatkan usaha bagi memerangi jenayah hidupan liar yang telah memberi kesan besar ke atas ekonomi, alam sekitar dan sosial.

Forestry Department, Ministry of Primary Resources and Tourism with the partnership of Yi An Photo Studio support (as the event coordinator) with support from relevant government agencies, non-government organisations and private sectors will be organizing the “Brunei Wildlife Photography Challenge 2022 (BWPC 2022) in conjunction with the “World Wildlife Day 2022” celebration with this years’ theme, “Recovering key species for ecosystem restoration”

The press conference was co-chaired by the Deputy Director of Forestry and the Manager of Yi An Photo Studio, as well as attended virtually by senior officials from the Forestry Department and members of the Competition Organizing Committee. During the welcome speech, the Deputy Director called on the public to raise awareness and appreciation of the importance of conserving wildlife by preserving its original habitat, which is our forests.

World Wildlife Day is an annual international celebration to celebrate and appreciate the diversity of the beauty of wild flora and fauna as well as to raise awareness of its importance and benefits to humans so that it remains preserved. At the same time, this World Wildlife Day is also to remind us of the need in stepping up efforts to combat wildlife crime which has had a huge impact on the economy, environment and society.

In conjunction with World Wildlife Day 2022, the Forestry Department will hold a competition called the Brunei Wildlife Photography Challenge 2022 where the registration date is open from 3rd March 2022 to 3rd May 2022. Further details of the competition including the terms and conditions of participation have already been briefed will be included in the media kit. For this competition, various attractive prizes related to wildlife photography equipment is on offer for the winners.

On 20 December 2013, at its 68th session, the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) proclaimed 3 March – the day of signature of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) in 1973 – as UN World Wildlife Day to celebrate and raise awareness of the world's wild animals and plants. The UNGA resolution also designated the CITES Secretariat as the facilitator for the global observance of this special day for wildlife on the UN calendar. World Wildlife Day has now become the most important global annual event dedicated to wildlife.

World Wildlife Day (WWD) will be celebrated in 2022 under the theme “Recovering key species for ecosystem restoration”. The celebrations will seek to draw attention to the conservation status of some of the most critically endangered species of wild fauna and flora, and to drive discussions towards imagining and implementing solutions to conserve them. All conversations will be inspired by and seek to inform efforts towards the achievement of UN Sustainable Development Goals 1 (No Poverty), 2 (Zero hunger) 12 (Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns), 13 (Climate Action) 14 (Life Below Water) and 15 (Life on Land).

According to data from the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Red List of Threatened Species, over 8,400 species of wild fauna and flora are critically endangered, while close to 30,000 more are understood to be endangered or vulnerable. Based on these estimates, it is suggested that over a million species are threatened with extinction.

Continued loss of species, habitats and ecosystems also threatens all life on Earth, including us. People everywhere rely on wildlife and biodiversity-based resources to meet all our needs, from food, to fuel, medicines, housing, and clothing. Millions of people also rely on nature as the source of their livelihoods and economic opportunities.

In 2022, World Wildlife Day will therefore drive the debate towards the imperative need to reverse the fate of the most critically endangered species, to support the restoration of their habitats and ecosystems and to promote their sustainable use by humanity.

World Wildlife Day 2022 Virtual Global Event: The 2022 celebration will be held online, and will seek to bring together representatives of UN member States, UN System organizations and multilateral environmental agreements, civil society, and the private sector for a series of discussions along the theme of “**Recovering key species for ecosystem restoration**”.
